Bronx Culture Trolley First Wednesdays Rolls Again on June 6th **Exhibitions | Entertainment | Book Signing | Shopping | Nightlife**

(Bronx – May 18, 2012) The **Bronx Culture Trolley** rolls again on **Wednesday, June 6th** featuring a number of family activities along the [South Bronx Cultural Corridor](#) including art exhibitions at the [Longwood Art Gallery @ Hostos](#), [Bronx Museum of the Arts](#), [Pregones Theater](#), [BronxArtSpace](#), [The Clock Café & Martini Bar](#) and the [Bruckner Bar & Grill](#). BCA's [bronxArtworks Artisans Collective](#) will set up their boutique of hand-made items in the Hostos lobby. The Longwood Art Gallery will also host a film screening and you can wind down your trolley night with food, drink at the [Bruckner Bar & Grill](#). [The Bronx Culture Trolley](#) is a program of the [Bronx Council on the Arts](#) (BCA). Admission to venues is free and all are welcome to hop on board and enjoy them.



June 6th's Trolley begins at the **Longwood Art Gallery @ Hostos** (Hostos Community College, 450 Grand Concourse at 149th Street) at 5:00pm for a meet-and-greet reception and a viewing of **40.85 °N x 73.86 °W: Home Is Where the Bronx Is**. *Home Is Where the Bronx Is* presents recent work by twenty-one 2010 and 2011 BRIO (Bronx Recognizes Its Own) award-winning artists in visual and media arts. This exhibition, co-curated by Juanita Lanzo, Edwin Ramoran and Kimberly Rose, is the third Bronx artists' biennial and focuses on the notion of home, cultural and political assimilation, personal narratives and histories, the construction of identity, the environment, the natural and urban landscape, and intimate spaces.

In the Hostos lobby BCA's **bronxArtworks Artisans Collective** will display and sell such imaginative creations as Korean knot-tying novelties, crafts, crocheted hats, ethnic masks, illustrations, jewelry, knitwear, metal sculpture, note cards, paintings, papermache masks and vases, post cards, and more. All items are original designs created by Bronx crafts artists.

The trolley bell clangs at 5:30pm, 6:30pm, and 7:30pm indicating the trolley's departure from Hostos on its way to the evening's cultural events. The Bronx Culture Trolley is your free ticket to a cultural tour along the South Bronx Cultural Corridor of the lower Grand Concourse. The Bronx Culture Trolley runs on the first Wednesday of each month (except January and September) providing Bronxites and tourists alike a fun way to travel via a replica of an early 20th-century trolley car. Passengers are given the opportunity to sample several of the area's hottest cultural attractions, dining establishments and entertainment venues along the way.

In addition to the Longwood Art Gallery @ Hostos, this month's trolley stops and attractions include: **The Bronx Museum of the Arts** for a Book Signing with Peggy Robles-Alvarado and her collection of poetry and prose, *Homenaje a las guerreras/Homage To The Warrior Women*; a guided tour of *Juan Downey: The Invisible Architect*, and a viewing of *Urban Archives: Our Town Pictures of the Bronx*, and *Lobby-For-The-Time-Being*; **Pregones Theater** for *Ayer y Hoy/Then and Now*, a dance performance choreographed and directed by Milteri Tucker and inspired by experiences of the Casa Boricua Senior Center seniors of BCA's SPARC program; and a viewing of *TRANSICIONES*, Tony Rocco's exhibition of photographs from Colombia and the US; **BronxArtSpace** for a viewing of ***Inside is not the Opposite of Outside***, an exploration in video, paintings, and performance of themes related to the subject of introversion and extroversion; **The Clock Café & Martini Bar** for a viewing of *Recent Work by Ezra Cohen*; and the **Bruckner Gallery for an art show with music...** sputnyc presents clinyc art * design * music with Manyc Records in the Gallery, in the Middle Room and on the sidewalk.

Please Note: The Bronx Culture Trolley WILL NOT RUN on Wednesday, July 4th. The Bronx Culture Trolley will roll again on Wednesday, August 1, 2012.
