Enjoy an End-of-Summer Concert at Pelham Bay Park on Friday, August 28th presented by Council Member James Vacca, Bronx Council on the Arts, and NYC Dept. of Parks & Recreation

(Bronx, NY – August 17, 2009) Council Member James Vacca, The Bronx Council on the Arts, and the New York City Department of Parks and Recreation present an end-of-summer concert by “Just Nuts” from 6:00-8:00pm on Friday, August 28th at Pelham Bay Park (Middletown Road and Stadium Avenue entrance). Admission is free and all are welcome.

“**Just Nuts**” is a Bronx-based, five-piece, high-energy dance/party band that has been rocking the Tri-State area under the directions of **Vic Sabatini** (lead vocals and guitar) and **Al Belfiore** (drums and vocals). Along with **Mark Doyle** (guitar, sax, flute, clarinet, harmonica and vocals), **Ceaser Monitto** (bass player), and **Joe Schuyler** (keyboards), they’ve been delighting audiences for years playing the best hits of the 60s, 70s and 80s!

Al Belfiore has been playing drums and singing since his early teens. He wrote and produced the "Concrete People" album and video that won rave reviews on early VH1 and played with such rock n' roll pioneers as the Teenagers, The Marvellettes, Larry Chance and The Earls. In addition to his gigs with “Just Nuts” Al has a full teaching schedule in his private studio. **Vic Sabatini** began his career playing guitar during his early childhood. Vic has played back-up for many oldies groups including The Drifters, The Teenagers, and The Duprees. Over the years, Vic has been an accomplished DJ in the tri-state area and has a demanding guitar-teaching schedule when he’s not on the road the “Just Nuts”. **Mark Doyle** is an exceptionally gifted musician having mastered in number of instruments. He write his own material- including a parody piece that was used on Saturday Night Live. He also maintains a busy teaching schedule and regularly performs solo at various senior centers throughout the New York area. **Joe Schuyler** was considered a child prodigy having mastered the piano by age 12. Joe was encouraged to pursue music by family member Felix Cavaliere of the "Rascals." He currently performs with the Westchester Swing Band and has a full schedule as an accomplished piano teacher. **Ceaser Monitto** has a music career spanning close to four decades. Vocally, he is known as the "crooner" of the group. Ceasar has worked with the orchestras of Steven Scott, Hank Lane, Ken James, Johnny Lawrence, Vigil Scott and the Westchester Swing Band, and has gigged with the likes of The Tokens, The Coasters, and The Jive-Five.
