Culture Trolley Saturdays returns on November 19th with a Special Artisans Trolley in a salute to the Comité Noviembre's Artisans Festival at Hostos Community College

(November 11, 2011 — Bronx, NY) The Bronx Council on the Arts (BCA) presents an afternoon of free trolley rides and attractions as **Culture Trolley Saturdays** returns, **from 11:00 to 6:00pm on November 19th** with a **special Artisans Trolley** in a salute to the Comité Noviembre's Artisans Festival @ Hostos. Comité Noviembre transforms Hostos into a typical Puerto Rican plaza with artists, sculptors, vejigante mask makers, etc. promoting and selling their wares while Puerto Rican food is sold from kiosks and musical acts entertain throughout the day. Workshops for children are being planned, like mask making, the history of the Three Kings' celebration, and much more! The day begins and ends at the Longwood Art Gallery at Hostos Community College, 450 Grand Concourse at 149th Street. Admission is free and all are welcome.
