Bronx Council on the Arts Adds Additional Nov 5th "How to Apply" Session for its Grant for Local Artists and Local Arts Organizations

(Bronx – November 1, 2010) The Bronx Council on the Arts (BCA) has added an additional "How to Apply" session for its 2010 – 2011 Arts Fund application and guidelines which are available online on BCA's website at www.bronxarts.org. The "How to Apply" session will be held at BCA's main office at 1738 Hone Avenue in the Morris Park section of the Bronx on Friday, November 5th at 6:00pm.

The Bronx Council on the Arts (BCA) is seeking submissions from Bronx-based arts organizations and artists for new public projects that have not taken place due to lack of funding or projects already scheduled for which additional funds would have a significant impact. This initiative is geared to organizations with annual budgets under \$100,000 for two of the last three years and to independent artists who are unaffiliated. This grant will only-support projects that demonstrate a community/public benefit.

Deadline for on-line submissions for the Arts Fund is Friday, November 12, 2010, 11:59pm. Grants range up to \$5,000. Projects must be completed by December 31, 2011.

About the Grant: Bronx-based not-for-profit arts and cultural organizations whose central mission is the production, preservation, publication, or demonstration of one or more art forms are eligible for funding. Organizations that do not have 501(C)3 status may apply if they are charity-registered with New York State (see www.oag.state.ny.us/charities.charities.html). All organizations must be Bronx-based and not funded by the Department of Cultural Affairs.

All projects — Presenting, Performances, Exhibitions, Film/video series, Workshop/classes, etc. — must be public in its nature and take place in a Bronx site.

Artist-initiated projects are eligible and artists may apply directly. The artist must be a Bronx resident with proof of residency for one year or more. Proof of residency includes: NYS DMV Driver's license, NYS DMV Photo ID, current utility bill with artists name.

<u>Directions to BCA</u>: By subway, take the #2 or #5 to East 180th St., then take the BX 21 bus across the street toward Westchester Square. Also by subway, take the #5 Train to Morris Park Avenue. Turn right out of the station, walk to Morris Park Ave, and turn left and walk until you get to Hone Avenue.
